


Cultural asset	Aqueduct in stone

Description	In the locality of Morra, there is a rare aqueduct with stone arches of medieval origin, which probably served a mill or hemp processing activity.








Cultural asset	Chapel of Madonna della Neve
Municipality	Aisone
Address	Frazione Lucerna (44.30527,7.24607)
Description	It was built in 1852, by the will of the factionalists. It was decorated in 1863, and equipped with a bell tower. Lusèrna is the grass that is given to the animals as soon as it is cut; in fact, the village is located in a large area of prairies. Only four people permanently inhabit the village, but it is repopulated in summer.










Cultural asset	Chapel of San Bernardo da Mentone
Municipality	Aisone
Address	
Description	It stands on the rocky ridge called Gardiola, downstream from the city. Probably built after the plague of 1630, it was later rebuilt in 1770. Each spring a celebration is held in honor of the patron saint of mountaineers in the chapel of the same name, which can be accessed through the Vio dal Préit.



Address	Borgata Rua (44.313656, 7.228273)
Description	Built by the confraternity of the Santa Croce by a family legacy; it was renovated and decorated in 1861.

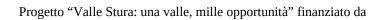

Description	Destination of rogational processions. It was renewed several times, particularly in 1691 and 1886.

Address	Frazione Forani (44.30845,7.24751)
Description	It was built by decision of the heads of the village family in 1747, and soon after with a house for the chaplain and school. He had a stable chaplain from the end of the 18th century until 1889.

Municipality	Aisone
Address	Frazione Pirone (44.31536, 7.20482)
Description	Built in 1830, in very modest forms, it was rebuilt in 1863. On this occasion, a space was created for the school. In 1878, the bell tower was built. A violent hurricane in 1970, ruined the roof that had to be rebuilt.

Description	Built in 1630, at the time of the plague that decimated the entire valley; it was renovated in 1860.

Address	Frazione Marchel e Lavoire (44.316818, 7.251885)
Description	It was provided with a house and school in 1870, but there is no record of a chaplain. The chapel was restored in 1964.

Cultural asset	Chapel of Santa Croce
Municipality	Aisone
Address	Via Santa Croce, 18 (44.31317, 7.21692 )
Description	The chapel preserves one of the rare 16th Century's frescoes depicting Christ crucified between the two thieves and the grieving Madonna. The chapel was probably built at that time, on the initiative of the confraternity of the same name, as a procession destination. Originally, it must have had the architectural layout typical of the chapels of that period; that is, a quadrangular plan with a cross-shaped roof. It was enlarged and raised in the 18th Century, and on this occasion, a new altar was erected at the back wall (which was to cover the fresco).

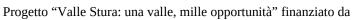

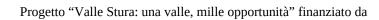

Cultural asset	Church of the Natività di Maria Santissima
Municipality	Aisone
Address	Piazza Matteotti, 2 (44.31276, 7.22011 )
Description	The church, of medieval foundation (14th century) still preserves the beautiful stone bell tower. The interior was reworked in the 18th Century and has a layout in the form of a nave with side chapels. It was frescoed in the 19th century and decorated with statues by Antonio Roasio. Beside the presbytery, there is a small exhibition of the "treasure" with reliquaries and silverware dating back to the 15th and 19th Centuries.

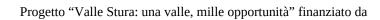






Cultural asset	Confraternity of Santa Croce
Municipality	Aisone
Address	Strada statale 21 (44.31276, 7.22011 )
Description	In the 16th Century, the confreres gathered in a smaller oratory that was rebuilt in the place where we see it today in 1642. Destroyed by the passage of the French-Spanish army in 1744, it was renewed again in 1776. The decorations on the façade date back to the middle of the 19th Century, but were retaken in the last century.

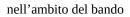




Cultural asset	Caves

Address	Upstream of the village (44.313713, 7.208701)
Description	There are numerous natural cavities upstream of the village of Aisone that were used by man in prehistoric times. Caves can be seen from the road and a short walk can be taken along the valley of the Borbone River: after the road to the Pirone, take a dirt track on the right that leads to a suggestive basin surrounded by walls and conglomerate towers. Archaeological excavations carried out in the fifties and nineties of the twentieth century revealed a seasonal agreement dating from the Middle and Late Neolithic Period (5th - beginning of the 4th millennium BC). Frequency at the Aisone site was probably also linked to the supply of quartzite, which could be found in the surroundings of the shelter and, more generally, in the area of the Argentera range. Subsequent attendance at the site shows transalpine and southern Piemonte influences (second half of the 5th Century BC).

Description	"Incursione" is part of VIAPAC, a European project that connects the city of Digne-les-Bains, in France, with Caraglio, in Italy, thanks to the works of twelve contemporary artists in places in the midst of nature or in cultural heritage buildings. The work consists of seven aluminum deer located along the main street of the municipality of Aisone, which appear as remote presences and which, however, the pedestrian certainly cannot ignore. The author is Paolo Grassino.






Cultural asset	Stone of the house "Sibilli"

Description	The stone was placed on the façade of a house; it has an engraved inscription that is difficult to decipher: it can be seen, among some symbolic signs, the word "Girardo" and the date 1608.

Description	Built where, according to the tradition, the Roman road passed, it runs to the hydrographic right of the Stura, almost parallel to the state road. It is shady and pleasant, but quite narrow.
