


Cultural asset	Bell tower of the cemetery

Address	Località Gippiera
Description	Remains of gypsum quarries, now inactive, according to Barelli (1835), were already being exploited in ancient times.

Cultural asset	Church of Santi Pietro e Paolo
Municipality	Argentera
Address	Via Nazionale, 20 (44.39606, 6.93853)
Description	The church has a façade with simple shapes, with a small staircase that precedes the entrance and frescoes. A chapel dedicated to Saint Peter has been documented in Argentera since the 16th Century, but it underwent numerous restorations and enlargements. The church houses one of the works most venerated by the local population, the "Blessed Crucifix", from the confraternity.

Cultural asset	Church of di San Giacomo

Address	Frazione Ferriere (44.35851,6.95497)
Description	Documented as a chapel in the 17th Century, in 1737, it was promoted to a branch of the parish of Bersezio for the convenience of the population especially during winter months. In 1906, it was consecrated as a parish and rebuilt again on a project of the geometrician Arnaudo di Vinadio, with the voluntary work of the population. As early as the First World War, however, the descending parable of the church began, and since 1985, it has depended on San Lorenzo in Bersezio.

Address	Frazione Bersezio - Via Maestra, 4 (44.37990,6.96952)
Description	The monks of San Teofredo di Le Puy built numerous churches in our territory founded the priory of San Lorenzo di Bersezio around the year 1000. Some traces of the medieval wall fabric are visible on the sides of the building. The most flourishing period was between the 13th and 15th Centuries. The interior has a single nave, where there are no fresco decorations on the walls and vault, rather several good quality wooden altars with canvases of the 17th Century. A Roman arula is walled up at the side.

Address	Frazione Ferriere (44.35815, 6.95488)
Description	The "Mizoun dal Countrabandier" is an old house in the characteristic village of Ferriere, at the top of the Stura valley, renovated and used as a "casa del contrabbandiere", that is a small museum related to the ancient and traditional practice of smuggling. The house was renovated as it appeared a few decades ago in the everyday life style of the time: a kitchen, a bedroom and the "soulier", that is, a large room with a wooden mezzanine. In each room, the exhibition of objects and utensils leads the visitor to rediscover ancient traditions and activities.
