

Cultural asset	Chapel of San Giuliano
Municipality	Sambuco
Address	Strada provinciale 144 (44.33837,7.06951)
Description	Near the cemetery - located at the entrance of the village - stands the ancient sanctuary of San Giuliano, which still has some medieval elements along the southern side, such as the walls and the single lancet windows. Unfortunately, part of the Romanesque aspect of the building was lost during the renovations that changed its orientation, opening an entrance instead of the old apse. The Bishop of Turin, Giovanni Ludovico della Rovere, consecrated this church as a parish in 1502. Its location outside the city and isolated from the villages makes it difficult to understand the reason for this choice, possibly due to the fact that the place is visited by pilgrims in transit along Stura valley. From the second half of the 16th century, however, Santa Maria del "Roccasio" was preferred, the most central one, to which the title was transferred.












Cultural asset	Church of San Giuliano
Municipality	Sambuco
Address	Via Umberto I, 52 (44.33732,7.07893)
Description	In the second half of the 16th century, the parish functions of the chapel of San Giuliano were transferred to that of Santa Maria del Roccasio, built, as its name suggests, on a rocky outcrop overlooking the various villages. The current appearance of the church is due to the numerous renovation works carried out between 1728 and 1796, when the choir, the sacristy, the bell tower, the side aisles and finally the façade were built.


