Municipality	Valloriate
Address	Borgata Sapé (Ubàc) (44.33188,7.33595)
Description	Built around 1650, it was initially dedicated to the Nativity of Mary. It later took the name Chapel of the Holy Cross (<i>Chapela 'd la Crous</i>) because of a relic that was solemnly transferred in 1804, but which was lost in a fire thirty years later. It has since been called the Chapel of the Nome di Maria. For most of the 18th and 19th centuries a priest resided there, who also carried out the role of teacher in the adjacent school.

Cultural asset	Chapel of San Bernardo
Municipality	Valloriate
Address	Borgata La Nova (adrech) (44.34355,7.37779)
Description	It was inaugurated in 1737, enlarged in 1789 and subjected to other works throughout the 19th Century. The frescoes on the façade date back to this period, which, besides the saint, represents San Grato's, the co-patron. Traditionally, the bell is rung when news of the death of a native from the neighboring villages is known, even if he has emigrated.

Address	Borgata Chiapue Soprano (44.33804,7.34737)
Description	It was probably built around 1715, and extended from the second half of the 19th Century. The patron saint of the chapel is Saint Rocco.

Address	Borgata Motta (La Mouta) (44.34266,7.36254)
Description	Saint Maurizio is their co-patron; the two saints were painted on the façade in recent times. It was built in 1783. It served populous villages, like Chiotti, Tiougalet, and Ntercatre. Adjacent to the chapel there was a school.

Cultural asset	Chapel of Sant'Antonio

Address	Borgata Brun (44.33777,7.37051)
Description	It is one of the oldest, well preserved. Built around the middle of the 17th century, it was rebuilt in 1762, to be inaugurated with a new blessing. Other expansions during the 19th Century led to the current structure. In fact, in recent years, it is the most popular church for worship and gathering of the faithful; but this type of concurrence of the parish already occurred in the 18th Century.

Cultural asset	Church of San Michele
Municipality	Valloriate
Address	Borgata Serre, 1 (44.33714,7.38052)
Description	The first historical testimony that speaks of a church of San Michele in Valloriate is found in a document from 1386, in which it is said that this church depended on the prefecture of Bersezio. The transformation of the primitive building, which still preserves Romanesque-Gothic features, took place in 1680. The church stands on a modest hill in a stream bend. The 2010, restorations have recovered valuable 18th Century frescoes in the apse: in the center there is an elegant God the Father and a Baby Jesus disguised as Salvator Mundi, surrounded by angels in flight, but the dove of the Holy Spirit is missing.

Description	At the beginning of the 20th Century, they tried to cultivate numerous coal mines because this gave them the possibility to avoid the military service. The most important one was located in Chiapue and was equipped with wagons on rails for transportation.

Cultural asset	Chestnuts museum
Municipality	Valloriate
Address	Frazione Airale, 24 (44.337269, 7.374079)
Description	The museum is located in the building in front of the town hall, in the central square. Within the multipurpose structure, the configuration presents all the pathologies of the chestnut tree, described in explanatory panels that are easy to understand and to illustrate which may be the most frequent enemies of our forests. In fact, parasites and the evolution of the various pathologies related to chestnuts and their fruit are reproduced visually. Numerous original tools, used for working the forest and its products, enrich the visit route.

Address	Strada provinciale 132 (44.335279, 7.387177)
Description	At the entrance of the valley (before the village of Serre), in a dominant position, are the ruins of a building now covered by vegetation that, according to the tradition, belongs to the old castle. In some documents, they are referred to with the name "Torre del Re".
